

France-Crew Crew Visa Requirements



Important Announcement from the Embassy of France

As of August 1st 2009, **U.S. Citizen** airline crew members on duty for their companies no longer need any visas to operate in France or in transit by France.

For Non U.S. Citizens please send the following:

1. Valid and signed U.S. Passport. Your passport must have a minimum of 3 months validity from expiration date.
2. One (1) visa application form. Application has two (2) pages. All questions answered and application signed.
3. Two (2) passport quality photos. Must be 2" x 2" and in color.
4. Letter from In-Flight Services which contains name, date of hire and position.
5. A copy of the front and back of your crew I.D.
6. VP2Go Visa Order Form.
